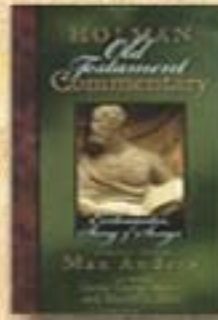

Biography



Dave Moore is the founder of Two Cities Ministries. He interviewed William F. Buckley for a television special that aired nationally on PBS. He also hosted a weekly radio talk show for over three years.

Dave has spoken at several universities. He has been a plenary speaker for the Veritas Forum and Campus Crusade for Christ. Other than the United States, conference speaking has taken him to Canada, Mexico, Croatia, France, and Poland. He has also spoken at numerous chapels for teams such as the San Francisco 49ers, Kansas City Chiefs, Chicago Bears, Chicago Cubs, San Francisco Giants, and the LPGA.

David graduated with academic honors from Dallas Theological Seminary and received his M.A. in Christian Thought (magna cum laude) from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. At Trinity, he was awarded the Professor C.B. Bjuge Award for writing the best thesis in theology. Dave was the co-recipient, along with his wife, of the Kitty Debaets Memorial Award for "academic excellence and commitment to family."

Moore is the author of three books: *The Battle for Hell* (endorsed by Wayne Grudem, J.I. Packer, and Dallas Willard), *Holman Old Testament Commentary on Ecclesiastes* which was chosen in 2003 as one of *Preaching* magazine's "best books for pastors," (recently translated into Korean), and the latest book, *The Last Men's Book You'll Ever Need*, which was favorably reviewed by *Library Journal* and in many other places.

Dave has written popular and scholarly articles which have appeared in the *Austin American-Statesman*, *Bibliotheca Sacra*, *Current Thoughts & Trends*, *Gospel Witness*, *The Huffington Post*, *Patheos*, *Reformation & Revival Journal*, *Stulos Theological Journal*, and *Touchstone: A Journal of Mere Orthodoxy*. He has been quoted in *Time*, *Moody Monthly*, and *TomPaine.com*

He is married to Doreen who is the author of *Good Christians, Good Husbands?* (on the lives and ministries of three eighteenth-century ministers). They have two sons.
